HONEY COMPETITION

OPEN CLASSES FOR HONEY IN GLASS OR PLASTIC BOTTLES

1. LIQUID HONEY, LIGHT, ANY SOURCE, 3 X 500G BOTTLES
2. LIQUID HONEY, MEDIUM, ANY SOURCE, 3 X 500G BOTTLES
3. LIQUID HONEY, DARK, ANY SOURCE, 3 X 500G BOTTLES
7. GRANULATED HONEY, ANY SOURCE, 3 X 500G BOTTLES
8. CREAMED HONEY, ANY SOURCE, 3 X 500G BOTTLES

LABEL AND PACKAGING CLASSES

9. LABEL & PACKAGING, HONEY, 1 LABELLED BOTTLE, FULL & 1 LABELLED BOTTLE, EMPTY

OPEN CLASSES FOR COMB HONEY

13. COMB HONEY, 1 SHALLOW EXTRACTING FRAME (see Section Regulations 4)
14. CUT COMB HONEY, 3 CAKES, approx. 7cmx10cm, presented in clear plastic, both sides of the comb to be visible

CLASSES FOR BEESWAX

17. BEESWAX BLOCK, NOT LESS THAN 1.2 KG, MIN. THICKNESS 50MM

CREATIVE CLASSES

21. EXHIBIT OF BEESWAX. MAY BE CAST OR MOULDED ON A MAXIMUM SPACE OF 0.5M X 0.5M. TO BE JUDGED ON ORIGINALITY.
22. PHOTOGRAPH, A4 PRINT. MUST SHOW A BEE OR SOME ASPECT OF BEEKEEPING.
23. BATIK, USING WAX RESIST DYEING ON ANY MATERIAL, NO LARGER THAN A3.

VALUE - ADDED BEE PRODUCTS

24. NOVELTY GIFT PACK. CONTAINING A VARIETY OF COSMETIC, EDIBLE AND/OR OTHER PRODUCTS. MUST CONTAIN OR CONSIST OF BEESWAX, HONEY AND/OR PROPOLIS.

The entry will be judged on diversity and overall shelf-appeal, with emphasis on a visual appraisal of contents for eye appeal and label design.

Honey Competition Regulations

1. Only standard plain 500g round utility glass or plastic honey jars to be used for all exhibits bottled honey in Classes 1 to 8.
2. Only standard metal or plastic closures may be used for all exhibits of bottled honey. Only yellow/orange or gilt/gold closures are permitted.
3. All bottles to be filled to the lowest edge of the lowest ring. This applies to all bottles, PVC, PET and glass.
4. All Framed Honey Exhibits must be protected by glass, cling wrap or clear plastic by the exhibitor, but the use of paper, lace or other decoration will disqualify. Dirt or propolis on frames will be considered a defect. **The Chief Steward has the right to refuse any entry which is not appropriately protected.**
5. **No exhibit may be removed without the signature of the Chief Steward.**

REGULATIONS

1. ENTRY FEES ARE LISTED IN EACH SECTION. ALL ENTRY FEES ARE A DONATION TO THE KZNBFA.
2. Entry fees must be EFT'd to the account detailed below or paid by cash with the entry. If paying by cash make sure it is in an envelope clearly marked and attached to the relevant entry. The KZNBFA and Honey Festival organisers will not be held responsible for missing cash entry fees or untraceable cash.
3. Entries not accompanied by an entry fee (if applicable) will not be judged.
4. No exhibits that have been entered in previous Honey Festival Competitions may be entered.
5. The KZN Bee Farmers Association respectfully requests the option to retain selected exhibits for display at the Royal Show, Garden Show or to auction. The owner of the exhibit will be advised and consulted.
6. Due to the closure of the Royal Agricultural Showgrounds all exhibits are to be collected by 11H00 on Monday 31 July. Exhibits may be taken on Sunday from 15H00 - 16H00, by prior arrangement
